### **Public Hearings for Uses of State Shared Revenues and Adoption of 2024-25 Budget**

The City Council will be meeting on June 24, 2024 at 7:00 pm at City Hall, 400 Main Street. A public hearing is scheduled for the purpose of receiving public comment on the uses of State Shared Revenues, as well as a public hearing to discuss the budget as approved by the Budget Committee. It is anticipated that after the public hearings and consideration of any public comments, a budget for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, will be adopted.
