November 5, 2024 General Election

The City has been planning on voters filling three seats on the Cottage Grove City Council, plus the office of Mayor, in the November 5, 2024 General Election. The Mayor's position will be a two-year term expiring December 2026 and the Councilor positions are four-year terms, expiring December 2028. The Mayor's position is currently held by Candace Solesbee; the Councilor At-Large position is currently held by Alex Dreher, Ward 2 is held by Jon Stinnett, and Ward 4 is held by Greg Ervin.

In addition, based upon the outcome of the July 30, 2024 Recall Election, the City anticipates voters filling two additional Councilor seats at the November 5, 2024, General Election. Those positions are the remaining terms of the Councilor Ward 1 position and the Councilor At-Large position, both expiring December 2026. The City elections official cannot accept filings for either of these two positions until those positions are vacant. At the latest, that should occur by Monday, August 26th, upon certification of the Recall Election results.

Be aware - August 27th is the deadline set by state law to file a declaration of candidacy or nominating petition for *all* positions.
