Street Striping

On Tuesday September 24th Lane County will be painting the street striping on the roads that were chip sealed this past week. They are; Thornton Lane from River Road to Whiteaker, E. Whiteaker from Thornton Lane to Gateway Blvd., S. Gateway Blvd. from Main Street to Taylor Avenue, N. 16th from Main Street to Ostrander, S. River Road from Harrison Avenue to Hwy 99, and R Street from Main Street to the Cottage Grove High School parking lot. Monday City staff will be posting no parking signs for Tuesday on R Street and River Road in the areas that have bike lanes. Please don't park in the posted areas next during the posted times to allow Lane County to stripe the bike lanes. Lane County will be painting during the day. All the roads will remain open for use as the paint dries within minutes. Please watch for the paint truck and avoid driving on the fresh paint.

City staff will be working as weather permits to restripe the crosswalks on the same streets though out the remainder of the month and October.
