# **EDA Main Street Revitalization Project**

# Week of February 17th - 21st

Mobilization begins on Monday February 17<sup>th</sup>. Wildish will install fencing for their storage site and begin to place equipment in the parking lot across from City Hall. There will be a placement of road barriers along the south side of Main Street.

Due to the weather, the prep work did not move as fast as expected.

NW Natural will complete work between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and the Main Street Bridge and move to the 7<sup>th</sup> Street area. They plan to complete their work by Friday, February 21<sup>st</sup>.

City Staff will be on Main Street preparing for the new water main installation.

# Week of February $24^{th} - 28^{th}$

Wildish Construction will start saw cutting the pavement on the south side of Main Street to install the new water main.

## **Cleveland Street Infrastructure Project**

Cleveland Street and the intersection of Cleveland & 6th Street in Cottage Grove will be under construction starting February 19, 2025, through the end of June 2025, for a full reconstruction of the road. 6th Street will remain open throughout the duration of the project. Cleveland Street will remain open to local traffic only. Work is scheduled on Cleveland Street between 7:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday through Friday.
