Background

The City has received a grant in an amount up to \$24,756.32 from Pacific Power. The grant is to be used specifically to provide funding for the support of installing electric vehicle charging infrastructure at 415 E Main Street, (City parking lot across from City Hall) and at 700 E. Gibbs Street, (City parking lot at the Community Center).

Grant funds apply to upfront costs associated with the installation and activation of equipment, along with outreach and education expenses.

In order to lawfully spend the money, the City must comply with the requirements of Local Budget Law. Expenditures in the year of receipt of grants, gifts, bequests or devises transferred to the local government in trust for a specific purpose may be made after enactment of a resolution or ordinance authorizing the expenditure. [ORS 294.338 (2)]

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution to establish appropriations for the use of the grant funds for the purpose stated in the amount of \$24,756.
