PERSONNEL MANUAL

Background

At the August 28, 2023 City Council meeting, Council reviewed a draft of the new City of Cottage Grove personnel manual. That draft has since been forwarded to the City's bargaining units for their review and assent. The units have until the end of Wednesday, September 27th to either assent to the manual or to raise objections and, potentially, enter into bargaining.

Significant changes to Oregon paid-time-off laws have recently gone into effect and are reflected in the new manual. In order to get the new manual into use in a timely fashion, it would be appropriate for Council to approve the manual contingent upon either the units assenting to the manual, or the time allotted for them to object elapsing. Should one or more units object, the attached resolution would not go into effect, and a new resolution would be necessary after any required bargaining. Should no bargaining be required, though, the resolution would allow the City to begin using the new personnel manual on October 1.

Recommendation

It is staff's recommendation that Council approve the resolution adopting the new personnel manual contingent on receiving no objection from the bargaining units.
