SUBJECT: RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING STATE SHARED REVENUES

DATE: June 14, 2024

### Background

ORS 221.770, pertaining to state-shared revenues, requires cities to adopt an ordinance or resolution stating that they want to receive state revenue sharing money. It further requires cities to pass a resolution stating that the City provides at least four designated municipal services. Provisions of the law require cities to certify that two public hearings were held: one before the Budget Committee and one before the City Council giving citizens an opportunity to comment on uses of State Revenue Sharing funds.


The resolutions concerning state shared revenues are required every year if the City intends to receive these revenues in the following fiscal year.


### Recommendation

It is staff's recommendation that the Council adopt one Resolution declaring the City's election to receive state revenues and adopt another Resolution relating to City's eligibility to receive state-shared revenues. These are two separate resolutions that are required.
