

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

***UPDATE! ***

On Thursday, September 19th Sierra Santa Fe will be applying sealant to the roads listed below:

- Whiteaker Ave between Main street and Mosby Creek
- Gateway between Taylor and Main Street (Both left and right side)

Due to the cooler weather and to allow the time necessary for R Street dry completely, the left side of Gateway was put on hold. Both the left and right side of Gateway will be done on Thursday.

Please expect and plan for more substantial road closures and delays as the sealer dries. A minimum of 2 to 4 hour delay is expected. During this time traffic will not be allowed on the sealed area until it has dried. The dry time is weather dependent. The warmer the weather, the quicker the sealant will dry.

Sierra Santa Fe has not given a time frame for Thursday's work. All of this work is weather dependent. I appreciate your patience. I am getting information out as soon as I receive it. City staff will be on site to assist. There will be no on street parking in these areas during working hours of 7am - 7pm or until sealant is deemed dry and safe to drive on.

Today, Sunday, September 15th, Sierra Santa Fe will be applying sealant to 16th Street between Main St and Ostrander, with a product called Liquid Road. Please expect and plan for more substantial road closures and delays as the sealer dries. A minimum of 2 to 4 hour delay is expected for dry time. During this time traffic will not be allowed on the roads. The dry time is weather dependent. The warmer the weather, the quicker the sealant will dry.

On Monday September 16th Sierra Santa Fe will be applying sealant to the roads listed below:

- South R between Harrison and Main Street – Beginning at 8:30 through approximately noon. There will be a street shut down to make sure they have the street ready to open for the busses to transport the children to and from Bohemia Elementary School.
- Gateway between Taylor and Main Street (Left side only) starting at noon through the end of the day. There will be one lane open and traffic will be routed accordingly.

On Thursday, September 19th Sierra Santa Fe will be applying sealant to the roads listed below:

- South R between Harrison and Main Street
- Gateway between Taylor and Main Street (Right side only)

Sierra Santa Fe has not given a time frame for Thursday's work. All of this work is weather dependent. I appreciate your patience. I am getting information out as soon as I receive it. City staff will be on site to assist. There will be no on street parking in these areas during working hours of 7am - 7pm or until sealant is deemed dry and safe to drive on.

On Saturday September 14th Sierra Santa Fe will be applying sealant to the roads listed below, with a product called Liquid Road. Please expect and plan for more substantial road closures and delays as the

sealer dries. A minimum of 2 to 4 hour delay is expected. The dry time is weather dependent. The warmer the weather, the quicker the sealant will dry.

Thornton Ave between Row River Rd and Mosby Creek

South River Rd between Harrison and HWY 99

R St between Harrison and the High School

City staff will be on site to assist. There will be no on street parking during working hours of 7am - 7pm or until sealant is deemed dry and safe to drive on. Please plan to park on side roads.

The Public Works Department and Sierra Santa Fe will work to finish the remaining streets as weather permits. We have extended the no parking signs through 7pm Monday, September 16th for these areas.

The remaining areas to apply the sealant will be:

E. Whiteaker Ave between Gateway Blvd and Mosby Creek Rd

Gateway Blvd between Main Street and Taylor Ave

16th Street between Main St and Ostrander Ln

R St between Main and Harrison

ROAD WORK STARTING MONDAY , SEPTEMBER 9TH!

On Monday Sierra Santa Fe Corporation will begin chip sealing 6 street segments;

☐ South Gateway Blvd - Main St to Taylor Ave

☐ E. Whiteaker Street from Gateway Blvd. to Thornton Ave

☐ Thornton Ave. from Mosby Creek Road to Row River Road

☐ N. 16 th Street from Main Street to Ostrander

☐ S. River Road from Harrison Ave. to Hwy 99

☐ R Street from Main Street to the High School parking lot

Sierra Santa Fe will be applying two layers of chips, a scrub seal using 3/8- rock first and a second layer using 1/4- rock. This work is scheduled from September 9 th through September 14 th .

The following week the contractor will be applying an Onyx Seal coat to finish the road work.

The streets will remain open to vehicle traffic as the contractor will be using pilot cars to direct traffic. Please expect short delays during this work. Please contact the Public Works Department if you have questions regarding the chip seal projects, 541-942-5501 press #4 then #2.

Middlefield Golf Course Paths

On Monday September 9th and Tuesday the 10th Sierra Santa Fe Corporation will be chip sealing all the golf course cart paths. The paths were significantly damaged during the process of removing all the woody storm debris from the January 13th Ice Storm. The course will be open both the 9th and 10th for golf play. On Tuesday September 17th the golf course will be closed during the application of Onyx Sealer over all the chip sealed paths. The sealer must dry before allowing people to use the paths.
