Through this cooperative working relationship, safety will be improved on our streets and sidewalks, and property owners will find it convenient for removal of branches from all of their tree trimming.

There will be a community drop-off site at the Row River Water Treatment Plant, located at 3300 Row River Road. Please look for signs pointing to the designated area. This will only be available through the end of the limb pick up, on May 23rd, 2025.

2025 Pick-Up Dates: May 5th - 9th, 2025 May 19th - 23rd, 2025

City crews will be picking up branches, the weeks of May 5th – May 9th & May 19th – May 23rd, 2025.

Their FINAL PASS will be starting the week of May 19, 2025. Limbs must be staged in accordance with our policy prior to 5/19/2025.

Limbs put out after that time will be the customer's responsibility to remove.



Tree Branch Pick-Up Program

- The Tree Branch Pick-Up Program is provided by the Public Works
 Department as a free service to residents within the City Limits. This does not apply to residents residing on Privately Owned Streets.


 ONE PASS through each designated
 neighborhood, each of these weeks.
- Tree branches are to be placed in designated areas only. They will be picked up and hauled away by the City Crew.
- Property owners are responsible for any hazard they create by placing the tree branches in the street.
- Property owners will be responsible for removing any branches or limbs left in the street after the City Limb Pick-Up work is completed.



Guidelines for Branch Preparation

- Tree branches are to be placed in the street where the CityCrew will pick them up.
- To assure that branches will be picked up, residents should pile their branches in the curbside parking areas no later than the Sunday PRIOR to each weekly pick-up.
- Branches should be no longer than 10' in length.
- Pile the branches so they do NOT block the bike or traffic lanes.
- Branches should be no closer than 30 feet from intersections.
- Street where curbside parking does NOT exist, such as East Main Street, Gateway Boulevard, and North 9th Street.
- Pile tree branches loosely on the street surface, within six feet of the curbside drainage ditch – DO NOT BUNDLE OR BAG THE BRANCHES.
